

ORDINANCE NO. 747-A

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 723-A BY INCREASING MOORAGE RENTAL RATES IN THE WARRENTON MOORING BASIN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The City of Warrenton ordains as follows:

Section 1: Section 1 of Ordinance No. 723-A is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1: The charges which shall be paid by all users of the Warrenton municipal mooring basin shall be assessed according to the over-all length of each vessel, as follows:

Yearly rates shall be \$6.70 per foot, with a minimum of \$167.50 per year.

The rate for each month shall be one-third of the annual rate.

Daily rates shall be charged for periods of less than a month, according to the following schedule:

25 to 30 feet	\$2.50 +	\$.80 electricity
31 to 35 "	3.00	" "

Section 2. All provisions of Section 1 of Ordinance No. 723-A, passed 16 December 1981, are deleted in favor of the provisions set forth in Section 1, above.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately on its passage, for the reason that the yearly moorage rentals on non-commercial floats become due the 1st of May and billings need to be sent in early April.
