

ORDINANCE NO. 751-A

Introduced by Commissioner Max F. BINGAMAN

AMENDING, BY ADDITION TO, ORDINANCE NO. 747-A, BY EXCEPTING FROM THE SCHEDULE THEREIN, THOSE CHARGES FOR BERTHS C-1 THROUGH C-6, IN THE WARRENTON MOORING BASIN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The City of Warrenton ordains as follows:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 747-A, shall have the following ruling inserted after the line stating "Yearly rates shall be \$6.70....." thus:

An exception to this rate shall be made for vessels berthing in C-1 through C-6, which, because of difficult manoeuverability and lack of electric hook-ups, will be let at the rate of \$40.20 per month or a daily rate of \$1.50.

Section 2. All other provisions of Section 1, Ordinance No. 747-A, shall and are herewith declared to be in force.


Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this amending ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage, for the reason that it is in the best interest of the city to rent out these spaces which, because of relative inaccessibility and no available electricity, are difficult to fill; and it is felt a more attractive rate will induce customers to overlook these handicaps.
