AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 711-A BY INCREASING RATES FOR SANITARY SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE CITY OF WARRENTON

The City of Warrenton ordains as follows:

Section 1: Section 1 of Ordinance No. 711-A is hereby amended as follows:

A. Residential collection, including multiple dwellings and mobile home parks: each dwelling unit is charged the minimum for scheduled service.

To continue the existing rates would result in an unfair subsidy of those using these services and an inequitable allocation of the city resources; therefore, the city finds a need exists and the rates, as set forth herein, shall go into full force and effect on 1 November 1983.
