AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 747-A BY SETTING A REDUCED RATE FOR WINTER MOORAGE, AMENDING ANY PREVIOUS ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The City of Warrenton ordains as follows:

Section 1: Section of Ordinance No. 747-A is hereby amended to add the following:

For those vessels wishing winter season moorage only, during the months beginning October 1 and ending March 31, each year, charges will be one-half (1/2) the yearly rate, providing moorage is taken for no less than three nor more than six months.

Section 2: An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage, for the reason that there is present need for winter moorage.
