

ORDINANCE No. 762-A

Introduced by Commissioner Robert L. MAY

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 747-A BY INCREASING MOORAGE RENTAL RATES IN THE WARRENTON MOORING BASIN.

The City of Warrenton ordains as follows:

Section 1: Section 1 of Ordinance No. 747-A is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1: The charges which shall be paid by all users of the Warrenton municipal mooring basin shall be assessed according to the measurement of the boat from deck bow to stern.

Yearly rates shall be \$7.05 per foot, with a minimum of \$176.25 per year; with the exception that the yearly rate for those vessels moored to "F" float will be \$7.40 per foot due to the additional wear and tear occurring to the piling, service dock and floats by these larger vessels.

The rate for each month shall be one-third of the annual rate.

Daily rates shall be charged for periods of less than a month, according to the following schedule:

Section 2. All provisions of Section 1 of Ordinance No. 724-A, passed on 4 April 1983, are deleted in favor of the provisions set forth in Section 1, above.

Section 3. This ordinance shall go into full force and effect on 1 April 1984.
