AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 762-A BY SETTING A MINIMUM ANNUAL RATE FOR "F"-FLOAT IN THE WARRENTON MOORING BASIN

The City of Warrenton ordains as follows:

Section 1: Section 1 of Ordinance No. 762-A is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1: The charges which shall be paid by all users of the Warrenton municipal mooring basin shall be assessed according to the measurement of the boat from deck bow to stern.

Yearly rates shall be \$7.05 per foot, with a minimum of \$176.25 per year, with the exception that the yearly rate for those vessels moored to "F"-Float will be \$7.40 per foot and a minimum 60-foot charged; those vessels in excess of 60 feet shall pay according to their actual size; said exception being made due to the additional wear and tear occurring to the piling, service dock and floats by these larger vessels."

Section 2. All other provisions of Section 1, Ordinance No. 762-A, passed on the 29th day of February 1984, shall remain in force as ordained.

Section 3. This ordinance shall go into full force and effect on 1 July 1984.
