AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING 1982 EDITION OF THE UNIFORM CODE FOR THE ABATEMENT OF DANGEROUS BUILDINGS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Uniform Code for the Abatement of Dangerous Buildings, 1982 Edition, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and by this reference incorporated herein, be and the same is hereby adopted as if the same were set forth in full haec verba.

Section 2.. The enactment of the 1979 Edition of the Uniform Code for The Abatement of Dangerous Buildings is repealed.

Section 3. Emergency. The City Commission finds that the city has several buildings which are presenting a hazard to the public and the safety of citizens of the city, and if the Ordinance goes into effect immediately upon its adoption, it will reduce the possibility of personal injury and property damage.

NOW, THEREFORE, an emergency is declared and this Ordinance is declared to go into effect immediately on its passage.
