AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 762-A BY INCREASING MOORAGE RENTAL RATES IN THE WARRENTON MOORING BASIN.

The City of Warrenton ordains as follows:

 $\underline{\tt Section~l:}$ Section 1 of Ordinance No. 762-A is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1: The charges which shall be paid by all users of the Warrenton municipal mooring basin shall be assessed according to the measurement of the boat from deck bow to stern.

Yearly rates shall be \$7.25 per foot, with a minimum of \$181.25 per year, with the exception that the yearly rate for those vessels mocred to "F" Float will be \$7.40 per foot with a minimum of \$444.00, due to the additional wear and tear occurring to the piling, service dock and floats by these larger vessels.

The rate for each month shall be one-third of the annual rate.

Daily rates shall be charged for periods of less than a month, according to the following schedule:

Section 2. All provisions of Section 1 of Ordinance No. 762-A, passed 29 February 1984, are deleted in favor of the provisions set forth in Section 1 above, relative to the Warrenton municipal mooring basin.

Section 3. Emergency: This ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately on its passage, for the reason that the yearly moorage rentals on non-commercial floats become due the 1st of May and billings need to be sent prior to that date.
