## ORDINANCE No. 816-A

Introduced by all City Commissioners.

PROHIBITING SMOKING IN BUILDINGS ON REAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OF WARRENTON

WHEREAS, the Warrenton City Commission finds that, because the smoking of tobacco creates a health hazard, it is necessary to protect the public health by prohibiting smoking in all buildings on real property owned by the City of Warrenton;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Warrenton City Commission does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Smoking is prohibited in all buildings on real property owned by the City of Warrenton, unless such buildings are exclusively leased to third parties under a written lease. Smoking is specifically prohibited in the Warrenton City Hall, including police department, city shops and the Warrenton Community Center.

<u>Section 2</u>. Any person who violates this ordinance commits a violation punishable by a fine of not more than \$100.00.
