AMENDING ORDINANCE 428-A, SECTION 1: RIGHT TO TRIAL BY JURY

The City of Warrenton, Oregon, ordains as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> Section 1 of Ordinance No. 428-A. adopted May 7, 1962, amended to read as follows:

"Section. <u>Right to Trial by Jury.</u> Any person charged with any criminal offense or where, by ordinance, a possibility exists of an individual being imprisoned, shall have the right of trial by jury upon giving notice to the municipal judge, in writing, at least ten (10) days, excluding Sundays and legal holidays, prior to the trial date set by the municipal court."
