## ORDINANCE No. 843-A

Introduced by Commissioner all City Commissioners

PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE (NFPA #70) ADOPTING OREGON STATE ELECTRICAL SAFETY LAW AND REGULATIONS, APPOINTING THE OREGON STATE ELECTRICAL INSPECTOR AS AGENT OF THE CITY, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 590-A

The City of Warrenton, Oregon, ordains as follows:

Section 1. The City of Warrenton hereby adopts the National Electrical Code (NFPA # 70) as amended by the State Electrical Code.

<u>Section 2.</u> That there is hereby adopted, and by this reference incorporated herein as part of this code as though fully set forth herein, all present provisions of ORS 479.510 through 479.990 (5), known as the Electrical Safety Law of the State of Oregon, as additional electrical code provisions of this city.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the rules and regulations and excerpts from administrative rules covering installation of wiring and electrical equipment code addenda prepared by the State of Oregon, Bureau of Labor and Industries, pertaining to the interpretation, administration and enforcement of the Electrical Safety Law shall apply to the interpretation of this code.

Section 4. The State of Oregon, acting by and through its lawful agents and employees, will conduct inspections and is hereby designated the agent of the city for the purpose of making all electrical inspections. The State of Oregon electrical inspector shall provide the city with the names and addresses of any electrical contractors working within the city boundaries as become known through electrical permits taken out directly with the state for the purpose of enforcing other ordinances of this city.

Section 5. That Ordinance No. 590-A, passed February 12, 1973 is repealed.
