

ORDINANCE No. 879-A

Introduced by Commissioner Jerry E. DONEY

REPEALING THOSE CITY OF WARRENTON ORDINANCES WHICH ARE FOUND TO BE OUTDATED,
UNCONSTITUTIONAL, SUPERSEDED BY CITY, STATE OR FEDERAL REGULATIONS OR OTHER-
WISE OF NO USE TO THE CITY OF WARRENTON

WHEREAS the Warrenton City Commission has found that it would be in the best interests of the city to repeal certain ordinances that have been outdated, superseded by other ordinances or state and federal regulations, unconstitutional or of no use whatsoever to the city or its citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Warrenton, Oregon, ordains as follows:

Section 1. The following ordinances are repealed:
