AMENDING CITY OF WARRENTON ORDINANCE No. 870-A, ESTABLISHING RULES AND
REGULATIONS FOR WARRENTON WATER DEPARTMENT AND ALL AREAS SERVED BY THE
MUNICIPAL WATER DEPARTMENT

The City of Warrenton, Oregon, ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 870-A is amended to read as follows:

Section 1. APPLICATIONS

(8) New services will not be allowed when the length of service lines or other hydraulic considerations would provide a level of service at the point of use that is below acceptable standards, which are defined as providing 30 PSI during periods of high system demand through a properly-sized meter. New services will be allowed only in areas where the system is able to provide an adequate level of service to existing customers throughout the year and where the public main is within 150 feet of the property to be served.
