

ORDINANCE No. 890-A

REPEALING THE REPEAL OF ORDINANCE No. 183-A

NUNC PRO TUNC, EFFECTIVE 3 MAY 1989

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 835-A was a housekeeping ordinance to repeal certain ordinances as a part of the codification by League of Oregon Cities and inadvertently included repeal of Ordinance No. 183-A; and

WHEREAS, the Warrenton City Commission finds that it was an administrative and clerical error that reference to Ordinance No. 183-A was included; and

WHEREAS, said city commission finds that it was never intended to have Ordinance No. 183-A repealed;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Warrenton, Oregon, ordains that:

Section 1:


Ordinance No. 183-A, as amended by Ordinance No. 716-A, be and the same is hereby deemed in effect at all times, and further ordains that the repeal of the same by Ordinance No. 835-A is repealed nunc pro tunc 3 May 1989, and the ordinances reinstated effective that date.

Section 2:

The Warrenton City Commission declares and finds that an emergency exists to maintain and avoid any legal challenges to the effectiveness of Ordinance No. 183-A and, therefore, this ordinance shall deem to go into effect immediately upon its passage.
