

ORDINANCE No. 905-A

Introduced by Commissioner Michael G. Murphy

DESCRIBING THOSE AREAS WITHIN THE CITY OF WARRENTON

OPEN TO DUCK/GOOSE HUNTING

The City of Warrenton ordains as follows:

Section 1. DESIGNATED AREAS:

The Warrenton City Commission designates for duck/goose hunting those areas as shown in Exhibit "A", hereto attached, and identified as follows:

- 1) A 50-yard strip along the Young's Bay shoreline extending from the old Young's Bay bridge to Vera Creek slough tide gate;
- 2) Beginning at Holbrook slough tide gate, extending along the east bank of the Skipanon to its mouth;
- 3) From the mouth of the Skipanon along its west side into Alder Cove, 100 yards, more or less, beyond the Alder Creek tide gate; and
- 4) That lake, commonly known as Wild Ace Lake, east of Ridge Road, and the wetlands surrounding the open waterway of said lake.

Section 2. DISCHARGE OF WEAPONS:


Use of firearms is limited to shotguns for the purpose of hunting ducks/geese in the designated areas, as described above and shown on the attached map (Exhibit "A"), which is hereby made an integral part of this ordinance and adopted herewith.

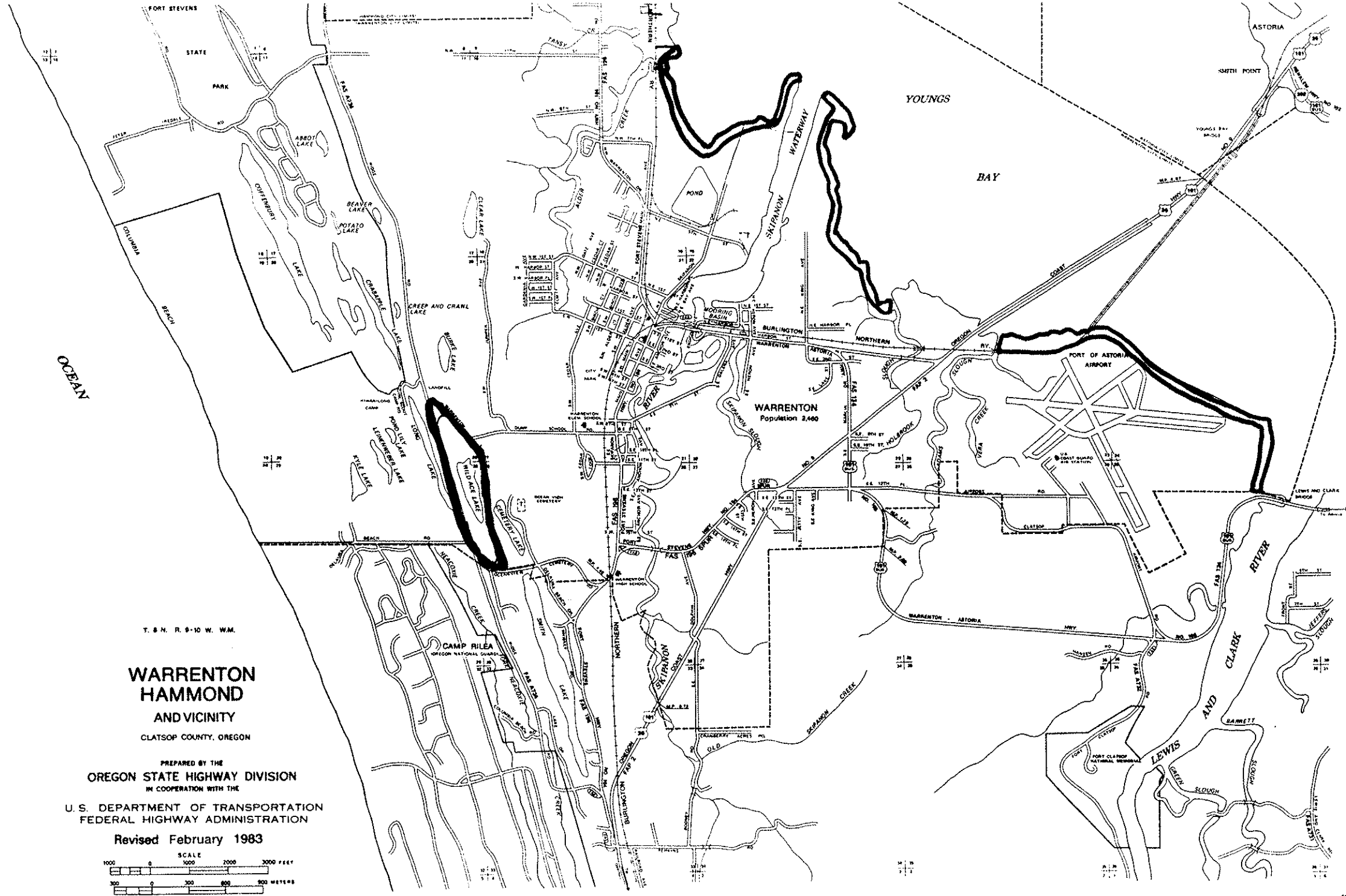
