## ORDINANCE NO. 916-A

# INTRODUCED BY COMMISSIONER Barbara Balensifer

## PROHIBITING CAMPING WITHIN THE CITY

#### EXCEPT IN DESIGNATED CAMPING AREAS

#### AND BY SPECIAL PERMIT

WHEREAS, the Warrenton City Commission finds that camping or recreational vehicles parked for purposes of lodging or sleeping, outside of designated camping areas, creates a hazard to public safety and;

WHEREAS, public camping and recreational vehicle parking areas are available within the city limits;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Warrenton does ordain as follows:

Section 1. <u>Private Residential Property</u>: No recreational vehicle or trailer shall be used for sleeping or lodging purposes outside of designated camping areas except by special permit from the city, said permit to be limited to one vehicle only at any one time. Permits may be obtained from City Hall for a period of up to 48 hours for parking of recreational vehicles on private residential property that is not designated as a camping area. Permits must be obtained in advance of parking the recreational vehicle or trailer in residential areas.

Parking must be in such a manner as to not cause a traffic hazard. There can be no discharge of wastes of any sort except into proper sewer or septic systems.

Section 2. <u>Seasonal Businesses</u>: Special permits for seasonal businesses may be issued for no more than one RV as registered to owner/manager of said business, for up to four (4) months upon application and approval by the Commission of the City of Warrenton. Application, approval and issuance of the permit must take place before the recreational vehicle is placed upon the property. The unit must not create a traffic hazard and can not discharge wastes of any kind except into proper sewer or septic systems. Arrangements must be made with the Sanitation Department for regular pick up of garbage.

Section 3. <u>Enforcement and Penalty:</u> Anyone in violation of this ordinance will be cited by the Warrenton Police Department. Violations are punishable by a fine of not more than \$300.
