## ORDINANCE NO <u>953-A</u>

## DESGINATING THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON AS THE DOCK COMMISSION OF THE CITY

THE CITY OF WARRENTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City is bounded on its North by the Columbia River and Youngs Bay and is bisected by the Skipanon River, all of which are navigable waterways in the State of Oregon. The City is actively engaged in Maritime Commerce and activities and operates two mooring basins.

<u>Section 2:</u> The City herewith designates its City Commission as its Dock Commission for the purpose of exercising any and all rights granted to a Dock Commission under Oregon Law, and specifically under the provisions of ORS Chapter 274.

<u>Section 3:</u> An emergency is declared to exist for the reason that the City Commission finds that this passage will allow the execution of certain agreements with the Division of State Lands and Leases for the Tansy Point Property forthwith, and thus is deemed necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warrenton, this ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately following passage.
