AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE V, SECTIONS 501 AND 503(f) OF ORDINANCE NO. 524-A, REGULATING THE USE OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SEWERS AND DRAINS, PRIVATE SEWAGE DISPOSAL, THE INSTALLATION AND CONNECTION OF BUILDING SEWERS, AND THE DISCHARGE OF WATERS AND WASTES INTO THE PUBLIC SEWER SYSTEM AND SEWER CHARGES AND PERMITS AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH

THE CITY OF WARRENTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE V, USE OF PUBLIC SEWERS, SECTION 501 of Ordinance No. 524-A is amended to read as follows:

No person shall discharge or cause to be discharged any storm water, surface water, ground water, roof runoff or subsurface discharge to any sanitary sewer. Cooling water or unpolluted industrial process water may be permitted to be discharged into a specific sanitary sewer, upon approval of the superintendent.

and;

SECTION 503(f) is amended to read as follows:

Any waters or wastes having a pH lower than 6.0 or higher than 9.0, or having any other corrosive property capable of causing damage or hazard to structures, equipment, and personnel of the sewage works.
