

ORDINANCE NO. 990-A

DESCRIBING THOSE AREAS WITHIN THE CITY OF WARRENTON

OPEN TO DUCK/GOOSE HUNTING;

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 905-A

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend Ordinance No. 905-A by eliminating an area in the city limits open to hunting due to residential development, and;

WHEREAS, the area to be eliminated is described in Ordinance No. 905-A as:

4) That lake, commonly known as Wild Ace Lake, east of Ridge Road, and the wetlands surrounding the open waterway of said lake.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WARRENTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. DESIGNATED AREAS:

The Warrenton City Commission designates for duck/goose hunting those areas as shown in Exhibit "A", hereto attached, and identified as follows:

- 1) A 50-yard strip along the Young' Bay shoreline extending from the old Young's Bay bridge to Vera Creek slough tide gate;
- 2) Beginning at Holbrook slough tide gate, extending along the east bank of the Skipanon to its mouth;
- 3) From the mouth of the Skipanon along its west side into Alder Cove, 100 yards, more or less, beyond the Alder Creek tide gate.

Section 2. DISCHARGE OF WEAPONS:

Use of firearms is limited to shotguns for the purpose of hunting ducks/geese in the designated areas, as described above and shown on the attached map (Exhibit "A"), which is hereby made an integral part of this ordinance and adopted herewith.
