

ORDINANCE NO. 999-A

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 982-A, RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR CONTROL OF BACKFLOW AND CROSS-CONNECTIONS FOR THE CITY OF WARRENTON WATER DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Warrenton, Oregon, adopted Ordinance No. 982-A on July 2, 1997, Rules and Regulations for Control of Backflow and Cross-Connections for the City of Warrenton Water Department and all Areas Served by the Municipal Water Department Outside Warrenton's City Limits; and

WHEREAS, the City of Warrenton's Water Quality Technician has requested additional language be added to Section 3.2.3; and

WHEREAS, the new language has been reviewed and approved by the Warrenton City Commission;

NOW THEREFORE, The Warrenton City Commission ordains as follows:

Section 1: City of Warrenton Ordinance No. 982-A is hereby amended by adding item "f" under Section 3.2.3 as follows:

f. Any new metered connection or system of two inches in diameter or greater shall be required to install a backflow prevention assembly device commensurate with the degree of hazard, minimum of double check valve; the term "new" as herein used in reference to new construction, annexation, or the City of Warrenton gaining jurisdiction over the water system(s).

Section 2: If any article, section, subsection, subdivision, phrase, clause, sentence or word in this ordinance shall, for any reason be held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not nullify the remainder of the ordinance but shall be confined to the article, section subdivision, clause, sentence or word so held invalid or unconstitutional.




