AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 982-A; RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR CONTROL
OF BACKFLOW AND
CROSS CONNECTIONS FOR THE CITY OF WARRENTON WATER
DEPARTMENT AND ALL AREAS SERVED BY THE MUNICIPAL WATER
DEPARTMENT OUTSIDE WARRENTON'S CITY LIMITS

WHEREAS, the City of Warrenton, Oregon, adopted Ordinance No. 982-A on July 2, 1997, *Rules and Regulations for Control of Backflow and Cross-Connections for the City of Warrenton Water Department and All Areas Served by the Municipal Water Department Outside Warrenton's City Limits*, which was previously amended by Ordinance Nos. 999-A and 1031-A; and

WHEREAS, the City of Warrenton's Water Quality Technician has requested a correction to existing language under Section 2.7.2; and

WHEREAS, the change in language has been reviewed and approved by the Warrenton City Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, The Warrenton City Commission Ordains as Follows:

Section 1: City of Warrenton Ordinance No. 982-A is hereby amended by changing existing language under Section 2.7.2 as follows:

Change From: "This assembly shall not be used for backflow protection of sewage or reclaimed water"

Change To: "This assembly shall be used for backflow protection of sewage and reclaimed water."

Section 2: If any article, section, subsection, subdivision, phrase, clause, sentence, or word in this ordinance shall, for any reason be held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not nullify the remainder of the ordinance but shall be confined to the article, section, subdivision, clause, sentence, or word so held invalid or unconstitutional.
