Ordinance No. 1075-A

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE MEETING DATES AND TIME OF THE CITY COMMISSION FROM THE FIRST AND THIRD WEDNESDAY OF EACH MONTH TO THE SECOND AND FOURTH TUESDAY OF EACH MONTH BEGINNING AT 7:00 PM AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 646-A.

The City of Warrenton ordains as follows:

Section 1. That the regular meetings of the Commission of the City of Warrenton shall be held on the second Tuesday and fourth Tuesday of each month and shall commence at the hour of 7:00 p.m. on said day in the Commission Chambers of City Hall, located at 225 S. Main Avenue. If either meeting day is a holiday as proclaimed by the State of Oregon, the government of the United States, or by action of this Commission, the regular meeting shall be held at a date and time determined by the Commission in its sole discretion, or further, may be omitted for that month so long as at least one meeting of the Commission is held per month.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 646-A is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance takes effect on March 8, 2005.
