ORDINANCE NO. 1195-A

INTRODUCED BY ALL COMMISSIONERS

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SALE OF RECREATIONAL MARIJUANA BY LICENSED MEDICAL MARIJUANA DISPENSARIES

WHEREAS, the passage of Senate Bill 460 allows medical marijuana dispensaries to sell recreational marijuana in limited amounts to persons at least 21 years of age beginning October 1, 2015, unless an ordinance is adopted prohibiting such retail activity in the City of Warrenton; and

WHEREAS, the Warrenton City Commission desires to prohibit medical marijuana dispensaries from selling recreational marijuana and other retail marijuana products;

THE CITY OF WARRENTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. In accordance with Section 2 of Senate Bill 460 (2015) the sale of "limited marijuana retail products" as described in said Bill is prohibited within the area subject of the jurisdiction of the City of Warrenton.

SECTION 2. The City Recorder is hereby directed to provide a copy of this ordinance to the Oregon Health Authority and the Oregon Liquor Control Commission upon its adoption by the Commission.
