## CANBY CITY COUNCIL WORKSHOP MINUTES August 29, 2005

The hope of City staff was to focus priority on one or two goals that could be completed. Staff also needed a clear idea on what services in the general fund the Council wanted to prioritize. The Council came to consensus on adding the following new goals: implementing an Economic Development Action Plan, relocation of police facility, study of regional police training facility, completion of Legacy Park in 2006-2007, and City finances/analysis reporting.

Another workshop would be scheduled on September 19, 2005 to prioritize new City Council Goals, discuss general fund revenues and expenses, prioritize general fund activities, and discuss budget strategies for 2006-2007 and 2007-2008.
