## EMERGENCY EXECUTIVE SESSION CANBY UTILITY BOARD ROOM JANUARY 26, 2000

Mayor Taylor called the session to order at 6:11 p.m.

PRESENT: City Administrator Mark Adcock, City Treasurer/Recorder Chaunee Seifried, City Attorney John Kelley, Mike Swanson, Mayor Scott Taylor and Councilors Carson, Harris, Daniels, Lucas, Strong, and Prince.

This meeting was called under the authority of ORS 192.640(3). The subject of the meeting was labor negotiations which was discussed in Executive Session under ORS 192.660(1)(d) at 6:00 p.m. January 26, 2000.
