SPECIAL MEETING

JANUARY 28, 1986

Mayor William Pulver presiding. Councilmembers present: Nancy Kopelk, Scott Taylor, Gary Sowles, Helen Brennan and Michael Jordan. Absent: Councilman David Anderson.

Also present: City Administrator Bud Atwood and City Recorder Marilyn Perkett.

Mayor Pulver called the special session to order at 7:00 p.m., followed by the flag salute. Mayor Pulver requested a moment of silence in memory of the seven Americans that lost their life today in the space craft disaster.

Roll call of the Council showed a quorum present, with one member absent.

Councilman Taylor asked if the City had planned any type of participation in the Oregon sector at the upcoming Expo. Councilwoman Brennan noted that the Chamber of Commerce has been pursuing this issue and would meet again on Thursday. Also, all information received on the Expo has been forwarded to the Chamber.
