Councilman Sowles chaired the meeting as Acting Mayor and opened the special session at 7:05 p.m. Roll Call of Council showed a quorum present.


The only order of business to come before the Council was a request for a special event liquor license by the Canby Bowl and a liquor license application of Michael and Ja'nice McAllister. The Canby Bowl had previously requested a special event license for a tournament and were asking for a three day extension, the McAllister's are new owners of the Claimsteak restaurant. **Councilman Taylor moved to approve the special event liquor license of the Canby Bowl for June 15, 16 and 17; and also the application of Michael and Ja'nice McAllister of the Claimsteak restaurant, as new owners for a dispenser, Class C, liquor license. Motion seconded by Councilwoman Kopelk and approved 5-0.

Councilman Sowles recessed the special session at 7:11 p.m. to go into workshop session on the dog ordinance and briefly review finances for proposed work at the Swim Center in compliance with a recent energy audit.

Councilman Sowles reconvened the special session at 7:42 p.m.
