

CANBY CITY COUNCIL

SPECIAL MEETING

JULY 7, 1981

Pro Tem Mayor William F. Pulver presiding. Councilmembers present: David Anderson, Beryl Brown, Lee Funrue, Michael Gabrion and Gary Sowles. Absent: Mayor Robert A. Swayze.

Also present: Administrator Harold Wyman, Attorney Wade Bettis and Steve Frederick.

In the absence of Mayor Swayze, Council President William Pulver served as Pro Tem Mayor and called the special meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., followed by the flag salute, meditation and roll call of Council by the Administrator.

Pro Tem Mayor questioned if there was any business to come before the Council. Administrator Wyman brought up the subject of the Public Works and Office Employees Contract which had been approved by all parties except the Council and also noting the contract was a two year contract. **Councilwoman Funrue moved to accept the agreement between the City of Canby and the City of Canby Office and Public Works Employees as presented in the contract, seconded by Councilman Gabrion and motion carried 6-0.

Pro Tem Mayor Pulver questioned if the Council was prepared to review Ordinances 616 and 601 regarding interest changes. Ordinance 616 pertains to the annexation fee per square foot of area and the 6% interest rate charged on the amount billed. Mr. Wyman suggested postponing this review due to the fact the Metropolitan Boundary Commission may be setting new annexation fees in order to maintain their existence and therefore the Council may wish to make further changes in our ordinance.


The Council briefly discussed Ordinance 601, regarding Senior Citizen interest rate on improvements and qualifications, the amount of allowable income. The Council directed staff to seek figures from the Social Security Department on income and bring up this Ordinance at the July 15th meeting.

At this time, **Councilwoman Brown moved to go into Executive Session under ORS 192.660, Subsection 1-b, labor negotiations. Motion seconded by Councilwoman Funrue and approved 6-0 by roll call vote.

Pro Tem Mayor Pulver recessed the special meeting at 7:30 p.m. to go into Executive Session. The special meeting was reconvened at 8:01 p.m. and immediately adjourned by Pro Tem Mayor Pulver.
