
Mayor Rapp called the Special Meeting to order at 7:10 p.m., followed by the flag salute and roll call of Council.

Councilman Westcott moved under ORS 192.610, sub-section I, to go into Executive Session on salary negotiations with the Public Works Director. Seconded by Councilman Swayze and approved 6-0 by roll call vote.

Mayor Rapp recessed the Special Meeting at 7:12 p.m. to go into Executive Session. The Special Meeting was reconvened at 7:25 p.m. and immediately recessed to go into workshop on the Comprehensive Plan.

Mayor Rapp reconvened the Special Meeting at 9:35 p.m. The Mayor reminded the Council of the workshop on Monday, April 28, 7:00 p.m., with an executive session before the workshop with Lee Engineering. Also, on Wednesday, April 20, at the "Old Town Hall" there will be a meeting with 20 county candidates present. Mayor Rapp has set Monday May 19, as a workshop with the Loaves and Fishes. The following dates will be set for the public hearings on the proposed Comprehensive Plan and will be held at "The Old Town Hall" above Cutsforth's Thriftway after 7:30 p.m.: May 12 and 28 and June 2 and 9.
