

CANBY CITY COUNCIL
Sepcial Meeting
March 26, 1979

Mayor Robert E. Rapp called to order a special meeting of the Canby City Council in the Council Chambers at 7:30 p.m., Monday, March 26, 1979. Councilmembers present were Beryl Brown, Beauford Knight, Leonard Taylor, Robert Swayze and Robert Westcott. Absent: Councilman Richard Nichols, due to family illness in Eugene.

Budget committee members present were Marilyn Perkett and Earl Oliver, with Mal Evans arriving at 7:53 p.m. Also present: Administrator Wyman and Treasurer Myra Weston; David Bury, Dorothy McCormick, center manager for Loaves and Fishes; Walter Dohrman and George Cattley of Loaves and Fishes; and Dave Blair of Blair Associates, labor negotiator.

Following flag salute, Mayor Rapp recessed the Council meeting at 7:32 p.m. for a public hearing on revenue sharing funds in the 1979-80 city budget. Gavel was turned over to Budget Committee Chairman Robert Swayze. The public hearing closed at 7:39 p.m., discussion continuing with Loaves and Fishes representatives and budget committee members. The budget committee session closed at 8:22 p.m., and the Council meeting was reconvened by Mayor Rapp, who recommended an executive session.

Councilman Westcott moved, with Taylor seconding, to recess into executive session as provided by ORS 192.610 for the purpose of labor negotiations. Motion carried 5-0. Recess called at 8:24 p.m.

Council reconvened after the executive session with Dave Blair, and adjourned.
