

CANBY CITY COUNCIL

SPECIAL MEETING

MAY 21, 1979

Mayor Robert E. Rapp presiding. Councilmembers present: Beryl Brown, Beauford Knight, Robert Swayze, Richard Nichols and Robert Westcott.

Others present: Administrator H.A. Wyman, Planner Stephan Lashbrook, Treasurer Myra Weston, Utility Board Members Howard Giger and Howard Barlow, Utility Manager Fred Egger, Canby Herald Editor Paul Borsarge, Oregonian Reporter Diana Schmid, David Bury and Earl Oliver.

Meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. Following flag salute and roll call Mayor Rapp opened the meeting to business.

A need was expressed to the Council for an appraiser for the Koehler property, noting Attorney Bettis' recommendation of Donald Hattan. Following Council discussion, Councilwoman Brown moved to enlist the services of Donald Hattan for assessing the Koehler property for the City. Councilman Westcott seconded, approved 4-0.

Mr. Wyman brought to the attention of the Council the decline in receipts coming into the General Fund, commenting, by June 1st, we could be in the red. An undetermined amount of receipts will be forthcoming, however, the amount is questionable. Mr. Wyman went over separate departments, noting either plus or minus in expenditures.. As of now we are almost at a moratorium concerning the budget. We may be looking at a net deficit of \$40,000. By the end of June a Resolution will be needed for transfer of funds.

Mr. Wyman expressed a need of two councilmembers for Thursday morning, May 26th, to interview for a City Patrolman.

Council discussed means of projecting and letting the public know the assessed valuation prior to budget election. Councilman Westcott moved to use the County estimated 60% average in projecting city assessed valuation to determine tax base. Seconded by Councilman Knight, approved 4-0.

Mayor Rapp recognized Mr. Wyman, Administrator, as today, May 21st, being his sixth anniversary with the City of Canby.

Mayor Rapp recessed at 8:04 p.m. for workshop session.

Workshop was adjourned at 9:30 p.m. and Special Meeting immediately opened and adjourned.
