SPECIAL MEETING

May 30, 1979

Mayor Robert E. Rapp presiding. Councilmembers present: Beryl Brown, Beauford Knight, Richard Nichols, Robert Swayze and Robert Westcott. Absent, Leonard Taylor.

Others present: Administrator H.A. Wyman, Secretary Marilyn Perkett, Canby Herald Editor Paul Borsarge, David Bury and Dave Blair.

Meeting was called to order at 7:32 p.m. Following flag salute and roll call Mayor Rapp opened the meeting to business.

Mr. Wyman reminded Council of Public Hearing on 1979-80 Budget and Resolution tomorrow evening, Thursday, May 31, 1979.

Mayor Rapp explained how Jim Hollister of KEX radio goes out and "invades" cities, many surrounding communities have been involved. He urged Council to be thinking of a "fun thing" we can do when they come to Canby.


Mayor Rapp recessed at 7:40 p.m. for Executive Session.
