SPECIAL MEETING

SEPTEMBER 17, 1979

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Rapp at 7:30 p.m., followed by the flag salute and roll call.


Administrator Wyman read a thank you note from the families of Al Roe, Mayor Rapp's father, for the flowers and expression of sympathy.

Councilman Knight moved to accept for recording the deed for property abutting on South Locust Street of Ivan and Dorothy Frazier, for public road or street purposes. Seconded by Councilman Nichols and approved 4-0.

Administrator Wyman read the permit extension agreement of Pacific Northwest Bell Company. Councilman Nichols moved to authorize the proper signing of the Pacific Northwest Bell Co. agreement. Councilwoman Brown seconded the motion and it was approved 4-0.
