
Mayor Rapp called the meeting to order at 7:34 p.m., followed by the flag salute and roll call.

Administrator Wyman read a staff report from Ken Ferguson regarding the Census Committee. This committee will join with the Census Bureau in supplying a more accurate 1980 count necessary for Revenue Sharing monies. Portland State, working on this count, says our population is going down and this is incorrect and the City could stand to lose a good sum of tax money. Mr. Ferguson recommended that the City should form a Complete Count Committee which could cost about \$5000.00. Mayor Rapp will review the information on this before taking action.

Councilman Westcott brought up the article that appeared in the December 5, 1979, Canby Herald regarding the park concerts. The article stated it was free, however, Jeff Durham noted that there was a correction in the December 12, 1979 edition of the paper.

Mayor Rapp recessed the Special Meeting at 7:48 p.m. to go into workshop with the Planning Commission on the Condominium Conversion Ordinance.

Mayor Rapp reconvened the Special Meeting at 9:15 p.m. and immediately adjourned.
