

INFORMAL LIBRARY BOARD MEETING - MARCH 18, 1965.

Mrs. Dick, Mrs. Matthew, Mr. Willming, Mr. Jensen and Mary Frances Gilbert met with Mr. Vincent in the City Manager's office.

The purpose of the meeting was to review the overall landscaping plan for the new library. Mr. Vincent presented a large drawing showing a master plan of landscaping for the site as proposed by his firm. Mr. Vincent reviewed the plan in detail and explained the various symbols of the landscaping drawing. It met with the general approval of the whole group.

The Library Board wanted to state that they highly recommend that the city retain Mr. Vincent to continue with the detailed landscape planning. This work would include the sprinkling system plus the specifications and handle the bid call. Mr. Vincent agreed that he would undertake the work for a hourly fee and would outline his proposal in writing for the City Council's consideration.

The group then went to the library site to review the tree trimming and tree removal currently being done by Mr. Henry Doyle.
