C. H. Ralston from the committee on ways and means reported - and on motion of A. Ervin the Council accepted the proposition of Messrs Miller and Smith to occupy their office for Council meetings free of charge

Mr A. Ervin from the committee on health and police reported The Town in good condition with a few exceptions of minor importance -
