On motion The bill of W.B. Donaca was accepted and a warrant drawn on The Treasurer for the sum 399 for jail fees

On motion The bill of fees of Recorder and Marshal on the arrest and trial of John Beard & Chauncy Charlton was allowed and warrant drawn for the sum - 500

ered to employ a Surveyor
to establish a grade on Main
Street
