

MINUTES OF BUDGET COMMITTEE MEETING MAY 16, 1984

The city Budget Committee met May 16, 1984 in Council Chambers of City Hall called to order by mayor Bob Smith at 8:30 p.m. Present in addition to Mayor Smith were Councilors Lyle Winters, Ron Miller Jr., Ron Passmore, Connie Camp, John Richard and Bob Armstrong. Also present were Lay Budget members Dale Rose, Merle Gilb and Russ Canaga.

Mayor Smith discussed the outcome of the City's tax base election and noted they were unsuccessful in passing the May 15 tax base in the amount of \$2,447,489. Mr. Thompson presented to the Budget Committee options including cutting the proposed amount and return to the voters with a revised amount.


City Attorney Glen Baisinger spoke relative to his views concerning the proposed revised cuts in his department. It was the consensus of the Council to leave the originally proposed amount.

Fire Chief Pickens reported to Council the relative need to leave in the part-time Fire Inspector position. It was his recommendation that this position would provide the City with help in preventing fire losses.

After considerable discussion, consensus of the Council to return to the voters on June 26th with the levy amount of \$393,588. It was the further consensus of the Council to agree to the revised proposals as presented except for the changes listed hereonin: Slurry-seal moved to the Federal Revenue Sharing portion; Fire Inspector position and the City Attorney left at the proposed level. Motion by Councilor Richard, seconded by Councilor Camp to accept the revised amounts as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Councilor Richard, seconded by Lay Budget member Russ Canaga to approve revised proposal as submitted and to allow Council to call for a special election on June 26th. Motion carried by a vote of 10-0.

MINUTES OF CITY COUNCIL MEETING MAY 23, 1984

The City Council met in regular session on May 23, 1984 called to order at 12:00 noon by President of City Council Lyle Winters in Council Chambers of City Hall.

Present in addition to Councilor Winters were Councilors Ron Miller Jr., Ron Passmore, John Richard, Connie Camp, Bob Armstrong, City Attorney Glen Baisinger and City Administrator Jim Thompson.

Dale Zimmerman of Seattle-Northwest Securities updated Council relative to the proposed purchase of the PP&L water system. After discussion, it was determined that Mr. Zimmerman and staff would report back to Council at a later date of their findings concerning the final costs of the project.
