

RESOLUTION NO. 17.

Introduced by Councilman I.M. Crandall.

Whereas, the recorder of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, did heretofore duly advertise and call for sealed bids for the purchase of Improvements bonds of the City of Lebanon, which said advertisement and call was duly given in pursuance of Ordinances <sup>Bills</sup> Nos. 150, 151 and 152 duly passed and enacted by the council of the said city of the 2nd day of December, 1913, and duly approved by the Mayor of the said City of the said 2nd day of December, 1913, Which said bonds are for the improvement of Main street from A. Street to the South Line of Carolina Street, for which applications have been filed with the said recorder for payment of the assessments on said street by installments, in the sum of \$16,520.71, and for the improvement of Sherman street from the west line of Third Street to the west line of Park Street for which applications have been filed with the said recorder, to pay the said assessments in installments in the sum of \$5560.63, and for the improvement of Grant street from the east line of second street to the west line of Park street for which applications have been filed with the said recorder for the payments of the assessments in installments in the sum of \$4741.84. And

Whereas, there is proof on file that the said notice was duly given as by law required, and

Whereas, the common Council did at the time and place in said notice specified duly meet and open all the bids for the purchase of the said bonds, and

Whereas, among others the Warren Construction  
Company submitted a bid for the purchase of all the said bonds and bid there for the sum of Par and accrued interest the same being the par value thereof and accrued interest and no premium. which said bids were separate for each of said streets, and were for the entire issue of the said bonds.

That the said bids of the said Warren Construction  
Company was and is the highest and best bid for the purchase



of the said bonds, and that being the highest and best bid offered there-  
for, and

Whereas, it appears to the council that a better or higher bid could  
not be had or secured at any other time or at another sale,

NOR THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL

That the said bid of the said Warren Construction Co  
be and the same is hereby accepted and the said bonds and the whole  
issue thereof for all said be street be and the same are sold to the  
said Warren Construction Co. at the said price.

And the mayor and recorder on the signing of the said bonds are hereby  
directed to deliver the same to the said purchaser or their order/
