#5-1914 RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon did, under date of December 1st, 1913, make and execute three certain issues of Improvement Bonds, for improvements, and in numbers and amounts as follows, to-wit:

	For Improvement of Main Street: Bonds Numbered 1 to 33, both inclusive, of \$500.00 each, Bond No. 34,	\$16,500.00 20.71	\$16,520.71
	For Improvement of Sherman Street: Bonds Numbered 1 to 11, both inclusive, of \$500.00 each, Bond No. 12,	5,500.00 60.63	5,560.63
	For Improvement of Grant Street: Bonds Numbered 1 to 9, both inclusive, of \$500.00 each, Bond No. 10,	4,500.00 241.84	4,741.84

WHEREAS, said bonds, as issued, do not bear on their faces any evidence as to which street improvements their proceeds were applied, or any distinguishing mark or marks whereby the bonds of the issue for any one of said streets may be distinguished from the bonds of the same numbers, dates and amounts for either of said other streets; now, therefore,

DE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEPANON, that, for the purpose of distinguishing said bonds from each other, the first issue above mentioned, being the bonds issued on said date on account of the improvement of Main Street, be known and designated as "Series A"; that the second issue above mentioned, being the bonds issued on said date on account of the improvement of Sherman Street, be known and designated as "Series B"; and that the third issue above mentioned, being the bonds issued on said date on account of the improvement of Grant Street, be known and designated as "Series C";

and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the City Treasurer, be and he is hereby authorized and instructed to so designate said bonds, in accordance with this resolution, by suitable entries in the bond register or record of the same; and that the Warren Construction Company, to whom said bonds were sold, or their assigns, are hereby authorized to mark each of said bonds, on the face and back thereof, so as to designate the series to which it belongs in accordance with this resolution.
