RESOLUTION FOR IMPROVEMENT OF GRANT STREET.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

That, whereas the Council deems it expedient and necessary that certain improvements be made on Grant Street in said City, as follows, to-wit: That said street, commencing at its intersection with the West curb line of Park Street, and extending thence Eastward to the City limits, be graded; that it be paved for said distance and to a width of 32 feet with gravel bitulithic paving; and that concrete curbing, and the necessary drainage conduits be constructed thereon; therefore,

The City Engineer of said City is hereby authorized and instructed to prepare plans and specifications appropriate for such improvements, together with estimates of the work to be done and the cost thereof, and to file the same with the City Recorder of said City not later than the 7th day of April, 1914.
