

RESOLUTION DECLARING INTENTION TO IMPROVE
GRANT STREET.

WHEREAS, by resolution duly passed and adopted by the City Council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, at a regular meeting thereof held on the 17th day of March, 1914, the said City Council declared it expedient and necessary that certain improvements be made on that part of Grant Street in said City commencing at the West curb line of Park Street and extending thence Eastward to the City limits, to-wit: that said street be graded; that it be paved for a width of thirty-two (32) feet with gravel bitulithic pavement; and that concrete curbing, and the necessary drainage conduits be constructed thereon; and,

WHEREAS, by said resolution, the Council authorized and instructed the City Engineer of said City to prepare plans and specifications appropriate for such improvements, together with estimates of the work to be done and the cost thereof, and to file the same with the City Recorder; and,

WHEREAS, said City Engineer has prepared and filed said plans, specifications and estimates, as by said resolution directed, and the same are now on file in the office of the City Recorder of said City, bearing file mark of the 7th day of April, 1914, and the Council has examined the same and finds them satisfactory as originally submitted and now on file, and approves the same; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
LEBANON:

1st. That the said plans, specifications and estimates be, and the same are hereby, approved, and the said City Council hereby declares its purpose and intention to make the said street improvements therein described and specified, that

is to say: to improve that part of Grant Street in said City commencing at the West curb line of Park Street and extending thence Eastward to the City limits, in the following manner, to-wit:

1. By grading the street to proper sub-grade;
2. By paving the roadway thereof for a width of thirty-two (32) feet with gravel bitulithic pavement, with full intersections;
3. By laying and constructing gravel bitulithic headers;
4. By constructing proper inlets and catch-basins;
5. By constructing concrete curbs where not already constructed;

2nd. That all of the grading on said street, and the paving of the street intersections, are to be paid for by the City of Lebanon, and the balance of said improvements are to be paid for by the owners of abutting property and property specially benefitted thereby; that the estimated total cost of said improvements, as shown by the said estimates of the City Engineer, is Twenty-one Thousand Five Hundred Fifteen and 55/100 Dollars (\$21,515.55), the estimated cost of the part to be borne by the City being \$5,207.69, and the estimated cost of that to be borne by the owners of abutting and specially benefitted property being \$16,307.86;

3rd. That notice of the purpose and intention of the Council to make such improvements shall be given by the City Recorder for ten days by publication in the "Lebanon Criterion", a newspaper published in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, which notice shall conform to the requirements of Section One Hundred Ninety-nine (199) of the present Charter of said City.
