

RESOLUTION ORDERING THE MAKING OF SEWER
CONNECTIONS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

That the owners of all lots, parcels or tracts of land situated wholly or partly within the fire limits of the City of Lebanon, or within one block in any direction from said fire limits, be and they are hereby required and ordered to connect all drains, toilets and water closets on said premises with the Sanitary Sewer system of said City within ninety (90) days from the date hereof; and be it further resolved,

That the owners of any and all other lots, parcels or tracts of land within said City, which are surrounded by or bordering upon streets within the limits of said City, the outside line of which lot, parcel or tract of land or any part thereof abuts upon an alley or street in or through which a public sewer extends, be and they are hereby required and ordered ^{to connect} all drains, toilets and water closets on said premises with said sewer within six months from the date hereof; and be it further resolved,

That the owners of any and all lots, parcels and tracts of land in said City which are not included in either of the foregoing descriptions, but which, or any part of which, are situated within one hundred (100) feet of a public sewer, be and they are hereby required and ordered to connect all drains, toilets and water closets on said premises with said sewer within twelve months from the date hereof; and be it further resolved,

That all of the said connections required by this resolution shall be made and done in conformity to the requirements of Ordinance No. 124 (formerly designated No. 116),

passed and approved on the 6th day of December, 1913; and
be it further resolved,

That the City Recorder cause notice hereof to be
published in the "Labanon Criterion" for a period of four
(4) weeks, and that copies of this resolution be posted by
the Plumbing Inspector in five public places in said City.
