RESOLUTION FOR IMPROVEMENT OF CERTAIN PARTS OF
GRANT AND THIRD STREETS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

That, Whereas a petition, duly signed by the owners of a majority of the property adjacent to that part of Grant Street in said City extending from the West line of Second Street, West to the railroad tracks of the Southern Pacific Company, and to that part of Third Street in said City extending from the North line of Grant Street, North to the South line of Sherman Street, has been duly filed with the City Recorder, wherein the petitioners request that said portions of Grant and Tjird Streets be improved by grading and curbing the same, providing proper surface drainage, and paving the roadway thereof with gravel bitulithic pavement; and,

Whereas, the Council deems it expedient and necessary that such improvements be made; therefore,

The City Engineer of said City is hereby authorized and instructed to prepare plans and specifications appropriate for such improvements, that is to say:

1. For grading said streets to proper sub-grade;
2. For constructing concrete curbing where the same has not already been constructed;
3. For paving the same with gravel bitulithic paving for such width as may be determined to be proper;
4. For providing suitable surface drainage, and such other accessories as may be proper for a finished job of paving;

and to prepare and file therewith estimates of all of said work to be done, and of the cost thereof, and file the same with the City Recorder not later than the 21st day of April, 1914.
