RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE ENTERING OF ASSESSMENTS IN
THE LIEN DOCKET, IN THE MATTER OF OPENING, EXTENDING
AND WIDENING GROVE AND HIATT STREETS.

WHEREAS, By Ordinance No. _____, passed by the City Council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, on the 3rd day of March, 1914, and approved by the Mayor on the same day, said ordinance being entitled "An Ordinance concerning the assessment and payment of damages and benefits incident to the opening, extending and widening of Grove Street and Hiatt Street", certain sums were assessed as benefits, over and above damages, against certain lots and parcels of land on account of the opening, extending and widening of said Grove Street and Hiatt Street, the said lots and parcels of land, together with the names of the owners thereof so far as known, and the several amounts so assessed, being as follows, to-wit:

Lot 8 in Block 5 of Center Addition to Lebanon, Oregon, owned by W. E. Hardin. Benefits, \$15.00;

Lot 7 in Block 5 of Center Addition to Lebanon, Oregon, owned by Jerome Smith. Benefits, \$10.00;

Queen Anne Addition to Lebanon, Oregon, owned by J. C. Mayer and M. A. Miller. Benefits, \$20.00;

A tract of land occupied by the Lebanon Creamery Company, situated at the Northwest corner of the intersection of Oak and Grove Streets, owned by A. F. Bohle. Benefits, \$10.00;

The North half of Lot 12 in Block 2 of Queen Anne Addition to Lebanon, Oregon, owned by R. W. Gibson. Benefits, \$10.00;

And, Whereas the time limited for appeal from said assessments and the fixing and determination thereof has expired, and no appeal has been taken or filed;

And, Whereas the Council deems it advisable to open, extend and widen said Grove Street and Hiatt Street is proposed in the proceedings preliminary to the passage of the ordinance above mentioned, that is to say:

To open and extend said Grove Street over, along, through and upon the following route and property, to-wit: Beginning at the Southwest corner of Lot 6 in Block 4 in Center Addition to Lebanon, Oregon, and running thence South on a line parallel with Grove Street to the North line of Elmore Street; thence West 60 feet; thence North on a line parallel with Grove Street to the Southeast corner of Lot 8 in said Center Addition; thence East 60 feet to the place of beginning;

And also to locate, widen and extend Hiatt Street over, upon, through and along the following route and property, to-wit:

Beginning at a point which is 60 feet South of the Southwest corner of Lot 6 in Block 3 of Burtenshaw's Addition to Lebanon, Oregon, and running thence South to the North line of Grant Street; thence Westerly along the North line of said Grant Street 30 feet; thence North to Sherman Street; thence East 30 feet to the place of beginning;

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

That the City Recorder of said City be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to enter in the Docket of City Liens the respective sums of benefits over damages, as aforesaid, so assessed as aforesaid upon each particular lot or parcel of land, and the names of the owners or other parties in interest in said lots and parcels of land so assessed; in like manner as assessments for street improvements are entered in said Lien Docket;

And, be it further resolved, that the said several sums shall, and the same are hereby declared to, constitute liens upon and against the said several lots and parcels of land and the estate and interest of the several owners and parties interested therein; and said several sums shall be paid to the City Treasurer of said City within twenty (20) days from the date of entering the same in the said Lien Docket, and, if not so paid, shall be deemed delinquent and thereupon shall be collected in like manner as provided by the City Charter for the collection of other delinquent assessments;
