RESOLUTION.

Regarding the widening and extending of Oak Street in the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON:

That, whereas the Council deems it expedient to widen and extend Oak Street in said City, from Hiatt Street to River Street, to the full width of sixty (60) feet, and to open, lay out and establish the same as so widened and extended; therefore,

The City Engineer of said City is hereby directed to make a survey of said Oak Street from Hiatt Street to River Street, and of such change therein, and to mark the boundaries thereof; and, further, to make a plat of the same, and a written report containing a full and complete description of such street and change, and of the boundaries thereof, and of the portions of each lot and tract of land to be appropriated therefor, and to file the said plat with the City Recorder within twenty (20) days from the date of this resolution.
