BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

That the system of keeping records and accounts in the Recorder's Office of said City, recommended by Prof. Sowers, of the State University, in his Survey of the City Government of Lebanon heretofore made and filed with the City Recorder, be and the same is hereby approved and adopted, and the City Recorder is hereby authorized and instructed to put the same into effect, insofar as he has not already done so; and, insofar as he has heretofore put the same into effect, his action in the premises is hereby approved.
