A RESOLUTION Adopting a Budget of Expenditures for the City of Lebanon, in Linn County, Oregon, for the Fiscal Year 1915, and Fixing the Tax Levy to meet the same.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, IN LINN COUNTY, OREGON:

That the following be, and is hereby, adopted as the Budget of Expenditures for the City of Lebanon, in Linn County, Oregon, for the fiscal year 1915, and the several amounts therein named are hereby appropriated for the respective purposes indicated, namely:

Be it further resolved that no city officer or head of a department of said City shall, during said fiscal year 1915, incur any liability or liabilities on behalf of said City against any of said accounts, which, in the aggregate, shall

exceed the amount hereby appropriated for his department, unless the Council shall have theretofore specifically authorized such additional expenditure or liability.

And whereas it is necessary, in order to meet said expenditures and appropriations, that, in addition to the other revenues of said City, money be raised by general taxation; now, therefore,

Be it further resolved, that, for the purpose of meeting the said expenditures of the said City of Lebanon, in Linn County, Oregon, for the fiscal year 1915, there be, and is hereby, levied upon each dollar of assessed valuation of property liable to taxation within said City, as shown by the official Assessment Roll for Linn County, Oregon, for the year 1914, now on file, the sum of eighteen and one-half (18½) Mills, the same to be collected as provided by law.

And be it further resolved that the Recorder of said City at once notify the County Clerk and the County Recorder, in writing, of the making of said levy, and transmit to each of them a certified copy of this resolution.
