Company has never entered into such contract; Now, therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY

Warren Construction Company shall, during the year 1915, enter
into contract with said City for the execution of said work on
the same terms as contained in its said bid, and complete the
same during said year, then said amount so forfeited, less any
extra expenses to which said City may be put by reason of ad-
ditional proceedings, advertising &c., shall be refunded to said
Warren Construction Company.~~


