BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
LEBANON, OREGON:

That, in pursuance of Ordinance No. 188 of
said City, passed and approved on the 16th day of March,
1915, providing for the extension of ASH STREET, and in
pursuance of Section 178 of the City Charter,
